- Tandem - Dr. Wicondra Stovall,
 - Grew up with single mom engaged in education/ Doctorate in education leadership. Principal in a primarily african american, private black school. July 2019, started partnering with schools to bridge that gap. Shift back into specifically in the Bayview, which organization I would choose. Equitable, early literacy opportunities in the Bayview 0-5. 90% of brain development occurs in the first 5 years of life. Communities most impacted, black and brown students. At tandem make sure we're supporting teachers and families, meeting where they are. Share experiences, share the books. The more you move the more fun they're having. Vocabulary has increased. Love for reading. Bring tens of thousands of books to the community we serve. When children can't see themselves in the books they read. Devalued in the society they are part of. Dr. Rudine, "When children cannot find themselves reflected in the books they read, or when images they see are distorted, negative, or laughable, they learn a powerful lesson about how they are devalued in the society of which they are a part."
- Huckleberry Youth Health Center - Keana Giles Been with Huckleberry for 5 years. With GLIDE and SF Foundation created Huckleberry. 1st Youth Shelter in the Nation. A lot of out of county referrals. Youth Shelter 12-17 short term program. We don't tell how long you can stay, +- 3 weeks. Family reunification. The goal is to get youth to a safe space. 24/7 if they come at 3am they come and they stay. Unaccompanied minors, 16 or 17 they get picked up for selling substances. Youth clinic that I work at currently started in the basement of Huckleberry house. They created a clinic in the basement. They're needs weren't being met. Need a space in their communities to find their identities. Spanish speaking therapist. Free therapy youth 12-24. You don't have to be with the youth to make a referral for them. Have all of their needs met in one space. Youth clinics one of six. Free primary and reproductive health care. Released from their Wellness Center at their school and can go to a Youth Clinic. No insurance or IDs required. Marin, similar to our site, very similar with their clinic. HART currently trafficked or at risk. Point
